The Delegated Act dealing with the Annex III (DoP template) is being developed and more information will be made available to our members.

Two stakeholders' consultations, one busy summer

With two European Commission stakeholders' consultations to be answered by the beginning of the autumn, Construction Products Europe's secretariat and members have been kept busy this summer. The European Commission has been asking for our analysis of how the different targets of the European waste policies could be improved and DG Environment has also released its awaited Sustainable Buildings Consultation. **Read more...**

ECO Platform launch event

The formal launch of ECO Platform will take place on 24th September. The ECO Platform is a platform for any Environmental Product Declaration (EPD) Program Operator in Europe where they can agree on common rules, principles and procedures which will lead to mutual recognition of EPDs across regional borders. Product Environmental Footprint

For the EC Communication Building the Single Market for Green Products and the Recommendation on the use of the Product Environmental Footprint (PEF), the EC invited stakeholders to submit pilot projects for a three-year testing period. The call closed on 26 July and approximately 90 projects have been submitted to the EC. These are now being reviewed and the list of selected pilots will be available by the end of September. Stakeholders will then have the opportunity to sign up to specific projects and contribute to its development. As soon as the information is available, we will inform our members how to get involved.

Construction Sector Strategy- new dates for Thematic Groups released

Following the July 2012 EC Communication on the competitiveness of the construction industry and its enterprises, DG ENTR launched five thematic groups earlier this year. After a first round of exchanges two reports were released. DG Enterprise has now released a new round of dates of thematic group meetings. **Read more...**
