CEN/TC 350 Plenary meeting 2016

On 10th of October, CEN/TC 350 experts met in Berlin to discuss the current state of the standards for the assessment of sustainability of construction works. In addition to the reports of the working groups the experts worked on the response to the amendment of Mandate M/350, to be approved by the EC soon. Read more...

EC Consultation: resource efficient buildings

JRC published last month the <u>results of the public consultation on core indicators</u> and a new <u>discussion paper</u> both documents were discussed yesterday in the 2nd working group meeting. The information collected during the event and the comments received in writing will be the basis for the new proposal. The new proposal and the discussions yesterday showed a clear support of our proposal to promote the LCA approach as the core of the system.

Joint Initiative on Standardisation

Construction Products Europe is participating in the development of action 5 of JIS focusing on the implementation of the CPR as regards harmonised standards. The group of stakeholders involved in this action will meet this month to discuss the proposals already drafted. The main goal is the clarification and improvement of the processes related to the development of harmonised standards paying special attention to the role of mandates, standardisation requests and delegated acts according to the CPR and the Standardisation Regulation.

BSI initiative on circular economy

BSI produced its draft for public consultation of a proposed Framework Standard on the Circular Economy and a 2-page flyer describing what the proposed framework standard is all about. The consultation deadline is set for 15th January. Read more...
