

Production in construction up by 6.9% in euro area
Up by 4.4% in EU28

In February 2017 compared with January 2017, sesconally adjusted production in the construction sector increased by 9,9% in the euro area for sector 2018. As a conceing to first settlimates from Eurosation the statistical office of the European Union. In January 2017, production in construction fell by 2.4% in the euro area and bit 1.5% in the EU28.

In February 2017 compared with February 2016, production in construction increased by 7.1% in the euro area and by 5.2% in the EU29

German government brings action against EC on the CPR

Two years ago the German regulator raised formal objections to standards for wood flooring and surfaces for sport areas on emissions to indoor air. The resolution of the procedure by the EC was the publication of Commission decisions (2017/133 and 2017/145). The publication did not solve the problem according to the German authorities.so they decided to initiate an action against the Commission including the request for the decisions to be repealed by a General Court ruling.
