

On 28th November, the European Commission adopted its 2050 "A Clean Planet for all" strategy. The Commission's vision for a climate-neutral future covers nearly all EU policies and is in line with the Paris Agreement objective. The strategy does not set targets but promotes the development of new and innovative industries. It seeks to ensure that this transition is socially fair and enhances the competitiveness of EU economy and industry on global markets, securing high quality jobs and sustainable growth in Europe, while also helping address other environmental challenges. 
EC consultations on EU product policy for Circular Economy and Environmental Footprint methods

EC action plan on harmonised standards (hEN) for a single market

The Communication published last 22 November, provides an overview of the functioning o the European standardisation system and presents four key actions to enhance efficiency, transparency and certainty of hEN. The consequences for the industry are a delay in the next publication of references in the Official Journal (last publication took place in March) until the new legal procedure for citation is developed and other changes related to the assessment of hEN by HAS consultants and EC staff. EC Consultation on public procurement of innovative solutions

The European Commission is carrying out a study of national policies that stimulate public procurement of innovative solutions. Within the study, indicator 4 is of interest to the construction sector. New delegated acts to be adopted by the EC

Two delegated acts will be adopted by the EC to unblock citation of harmonised standards under the CPR. The first delegated act deals with the classification in relation to

resistance to wind load for external blinds and awnings finished, <u>read more...</u> The second with rooflights and roof hatches in relation to air permeability, <u>read more...</u> The comments to both documents will be considered by the EC before adoption. The final version will be sent to the European Parliament and the Council for scrutiny.
