EU renovation wave & online meeting with Commissioner Simson

After the two meeting that were held with Commissioner Breton, on 23rd April, we were invited to speak to Commissioner Simson, who heads DG Energy and leads the work on the announced Renovation Wave. Links were made between the COVID-19 crisis, the EU recovery package, the Green Deal and decarbonising the EU building stock as part of the EU climate targets. We



underlined the job creation opportunities and welfare of citizens who would benefit from such investments.

To assist the Commision in the preparation of the EU Recovery Fund, we joined EBC and FIEC and published a joint declaration putting construction as priority with at least €320B dedicated budget.

New DG Growth Director General

SCIP database

ECHA published a leaflet to get a quick introduction to the SCIP database and the obligations of manufacturers, importers and distributors of articles containing SVHCs on ECHA's Candidate List in a concentration above 0.1 % weight by weight to notify them to the SCIP database. The SCIP notification obligation for companies applies from January 2021 but Construction Products Europe requested together with other European organisations a delay in the implementation due to the COVID-19 crisis. ECHA is committed to helping industry meet its regulatory obligations during the COVID-19 pandemic. Therefore, the Agency has decided on a number of deadline extensions which will apply until end of May 2020. The companies concerned have been informed directly about these extensions since the end of March. Read more...
